## Dangerous Seeds: GMO's in Agriculture

In the summer of 2005, for the first time!, genetically manipulated plants were cultivated in Germany on a commercial scale. This happened and is happening against the will of the majority of the population. About eighty per cent of people in Germany are against genetic engineering in agriculture and don't want to either consume or cultivate GMO's. The new government doesn't care about opinion polls, and agro-genetic engineering threatens to stage a massive entry onto the scene.

The people responsible for this know they are creating irreversible facts. Once released into nature, GM organisms can't be taken back. Genetically manipulated genotype spreads uncontrollably through pollen flight and cross pollination. Genetically implanted features completely alien to a particular species then cross with related wild plants.

The cultivation of GMO's is a massive global threat to traditional agriculture. Experiences from Canada and the USA clearly prove that an harmonious, parallel existence of GMO-free agriculture and GMO's is impossible as suggested by the term "co-existence" introduced by the pro-GM lobby. Agro-genetic engineering by contrast leads to greater dependency of farmers on large seed companies. Percy Schmeiser, a Canadian farmer, has been sued by Monsanto because patented GM plants were found on his fields. Pollen and seed had landed on his land from the neighbouring farm and passing tractor traffic. But instead of being indemnified for the contamination, the court pronounced him guilty (see <a href="https://www.percyschmeiser.com">www.percyschmeiser.com</a>).

The cultivation of GMO's finishes off biological diversity. Traditional species of plants are supplanted. The poison produced by certain GM-varieties of corn not only destroys problematic pests, but a multitude of other insects. Genetically manipulated organisms present a danger to health. It is impossible to restrict the health risks for human beings and animals.

Genetic engineering is a throwing of the dice. Genetic constructs are stuck onto an unknown genome at an accidental place. Again and again, outcomes occur nobody bargained with: The stems of gm-soja for example burst during heat or a drought, GM-poplars are flowering at the wrong time. Many scientists are warning that the highly dynamic system turns manipulations into a great risk.

## We do not tolerate that!

The association "Gendreck-weg" (chuck genetic muck) was created by bee-keepers and farmers in order to help fight the insanity of agro-genetic engineering. In the meantime, biologists, gardeners, mothers and fathers, medical personnel, cooks and many other people have joined in. New "comrades-in-arms" are welcome.

After public announcements we are going to walk on fields with genetically modified corn to tear out those dangerous plants. It is not our aim to harm the farmers but to avert the danger.

We regard our action as selfdefence, as a necessary act of civil courage to bring spreading of GMO on our fields to a standstill. That way we act in the tradition of non-violent resistance.

More and more people are announcing their readiness to free fields of GMO. Every public declaration of intention or solidarity gives way to civil discussions and effects the political process.

The planned actions will take place if at least 250 people have announced their purpose.

We are not alone. In Africa, Asia, America and many European countries hundreds of thousands of people have become active in similar ways.

In the last six month there have been proceedings at law in France in Orleans and Versailles. GMO activists have been absolved. They had destroyed GMO-fields. Courts have acknowledged the matter that the action was directed to the protection of agriculture and the health of the population.

It is high time. Both the legal system and politics have to ensure that the principle of prevention is respected. Where this is not the case and genetically manipulated seeds are sown, we are left with the principle of averting a great peril. As responsible citizens we will stop this fatal development. Non-violently, publicly and in a determined fashion.

Germany and Europe remain GMO-free. This is the only way to stop the global application of this risk technology and to enjoy a future of healthy food, independent farmers and agricultural diversity.
